Trunk or Treat Car Guidelines

Thanks for volunteering to decorate your vehicle for Trunk or Treat!

If you are new to Trunk or Treat, it is an event where volunteers decorate the trunks of their cars and fill them with individually wrapped candy for the children, provided by donations from church members. The children walk by the cars and receive candy at each decorated car. It is a great time for the children to enjoy the evening and not feel scared about trick or treating, and it is a great opportunity to introduce families to our church.

This is a rain or shine event. If the weather does not permit us to be outside, then you will decorate a table in the Fellowship Hall. There are lots of creative, family friendly ways that you can decorate your vehicle. We recommend that you pick a theme for your vehicle and your costume.

Here are some suggested themes:

Below are some guidelines:

- Parking lot opens at 3:30 PM Saturday Oct 27 and cars should be ready by 4 PM
- Vehicle must fit in a regular parking space
- Decorate your trunk/vehicle. No scary/violent/demonic decorations. No toy weapons--- guns, knives, etc. No open flames, fireworks, or flammable materials
- Vehicle can not be left unattended and must be turned off for the duration of the event.
- Some candy/trinkets may be available. **Please remember we are a nut free environment.**
- Costumes are encouraged.
- Rain or shine-you may use a pop-up awning if it fits in your allotted space.
- You are responsible for cleaning up your area before leaving. Parking lot will be open to leaving cars at 6:15 PM
- No electricity is available. You must provide your own generator if power is needed.
- This is an alcohol free event
